

## **The Vicki and Patrick Kunke Scholarship**

### **BACKGROUND**

This scholarship was established in 2006 by Vicki (Neff) and Patrick Kunke, 1967 Teays Valley High School graduates, as a \$1,000 grant. It is intended to assist a graduating TVHS senior with first-year college/university expenses. The recipient may apply the grant to expenses at his/her discretion.

The scholarship will be awarded annually to a single recipient.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants shall be graduating TVHS seniors. While this is not solely an academic scholarship, applicants must demonstrate academic promise and good character. A minimum 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale) or 4.0 GPA (5.0 scale) is required.

No restrictions are to be made regarding the applicant's eligibility based upon race, religion, or scholastic standing.

Selection of the recipient is to be solely at the discretion of the trustees of this scholarship.

### **APPLICATION**

Qualified students desiring consideration for this scholarship must:

1. Obtain the appropriate application forms from the TVHS guidance office.
2. Fully complete and return the application forms to the guidance office no later than April 10 of the respective academic year of award.
3. Attach two sealed letters of reference from a teacher or community leader to the application materials.
4. Include an official copy of the student's high school transcript, dated after January 1 of the award year.
5. Compose a one-page essay (single side only; single or double-spaced acceptable) in which the applicant has the opportunity to provide additional relevant information supporting his/her deserving to be selected.

NOTES:

- All components of the application are important. The applicant should carefully follow all directions, and pay close attention to spelling, grammar, content and completeness.
- The applicant should black out any social security numbers on personal documents before they are submitted.
