The Teays Valley Educational Foundation is offering a \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship that was established to honor the memory of Richard Cline. Chief Cline, a Marine Corps veteran, served for 37 years on the City of Columbus Fire Department, retiring as Assistant Chief in 1997. Chief Cline passed away in 2011 after a battle with cancer.

After getting married and raising a family, she returned to the classroom in the 1950s teaching at Walnut Elementary and later Teays Valley Middle School. She retired in 1973. Helen Baker Noecker was a dedicated teacher who cared deeply about education and her students. She kept in touch with many of her students up until her death in 2003.
