
Commercial Point Community Men's Club Foundation Scholarship Fund

The purpose of this scholarship fund is to encourage the recipient(s) to obtain a degree in higher education.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

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1.	As stated in the above paragraph, the applicant must presently be a resident of Scioto Township and have attended Teays Valley West Middle School for at least one year. Please state the year/years that you attended Teays Valley West Middle School. Year/years attending TVWMS
2.	Applicant must be a graduating senior of the 2024 graduating class of Teays Valley High School.
3.	Applicant must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA overall during high school.
4.	Applicant must fill out all forms and answer all questions to the best of their ability to be eligible.
5.	All applicants must submit their application packet to Mrs. Younkin, Teays Valley High School Guidance Counselor by March 22, 2024.
6.	All applications must be in typed form or printed neatly.
7.	All applications for the scholarships will be reviewed by the Commercial Point Community Men's Club Foundation Scholarship Fund Committee and make their decision on the recipient(s).

<u>Academic Information</u> – Please provide an official copy of your transcript and ACT score for the committee to review. From this document, the committee will be able to view your GPA, course selections, attendance history, and testing scores.

<u>Recommendations</u> – Each applicant must provide two (2) letters of recommendation. These recommendations should be written by someone who knows your personal character. Examples: Teacher, Coach, Minister, Employer, Community Leader, etc. Please attach these letters to your application. (All members of the Commercial Point Men's Club are exempt from giving a recommendation letter)

Essays – Please type on separate paper, a paragraph of at least 150 words, describing why you feel that you should be a recipient of this scholarship and how it will benefit you in the future.

Please type on separate paper, a paragraph of at least 150 words, describing your high school and community service activities (school related volunteer opportunities and community service) that you have participated in that were meaningful and what you learned from the experience.

<u>Distribution of Scholarship Funds</u> – One-half of scholarship monies are payable to the recipient after proof of enrollment to the college of the recipient's choice. The second-half of scholarship monies will be made once the Men's Club Foundation Committee receives your first semester grades. Grades may be sent to the Commercial Point Community Men's Club Foundation, c/o Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 97, 26 W. Scioto St., Commercial Point, Ohio 43116. In the event that the recipient drops out of school for any reason, other than an emergency, all future scholarship monies not paid to the student are forfeited. In the case of an emergency, the recipient is urged to contact the Commercial Point Community Men's Club Foundation Scholarship Committee and ask for a waiver to be granted. The recipient of the scholarship/scholarships are requested to attend the Commercial Point Community Men's Club meeting, 26 W. Scioto St., Commercial Point, Ohio on June 24, or July 29, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. for a "meet and greet" night with the Men's Club Foundation.
