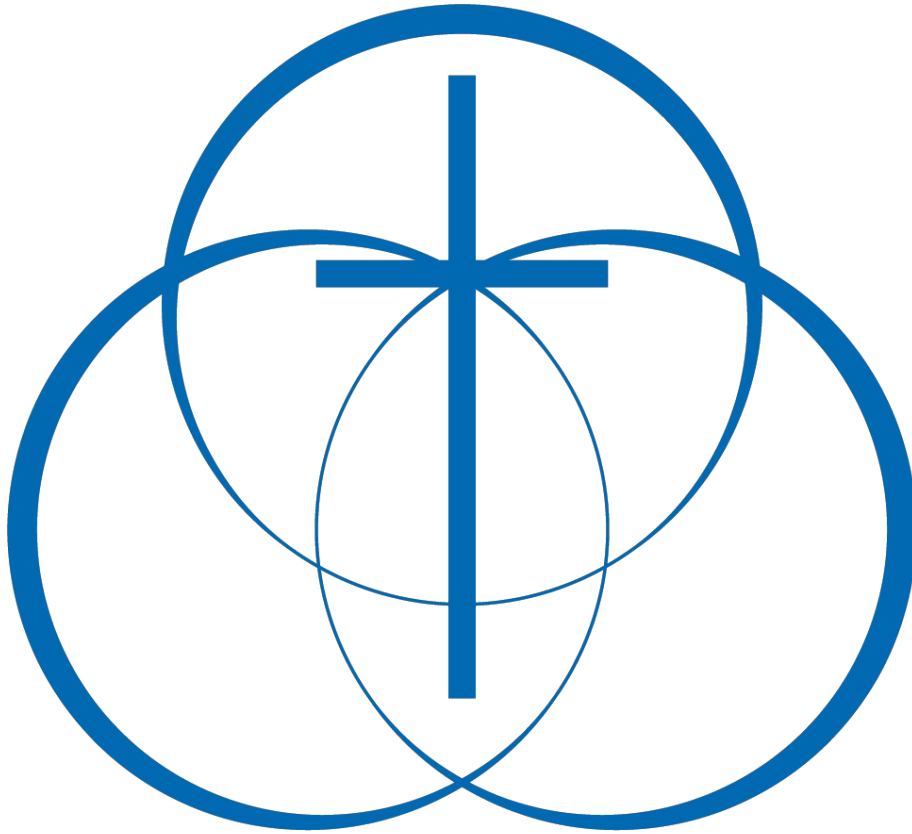

PURPOSE

Global Methodist on Main (GMoM), as part of its Outreach Program, has a fund to provide scholarships to Scioto Township residents and/or member constituents of the GMoM. The purpose of this scholarship fund is to encourage the recipient(s) to obtain a degree in higher education. The benefits the fund provides are not intended to meet the total financial obligation of a student attending an accredited college or university.

The fund has been made possible primarily through the bequests of the following estates: Gladys Linnaberry, Jerry Rasor, and Benjamin and Evelyn Grace. In addition, other individuals have made contributions to the scholarship fund.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

***RESIDENCE:* The applicant and parent/legal guardian of a minor applicant (under 18 years of age) has maintained his/her residence and lived in Scioto Township prior to the first day of school of the year the student entered the 9th grade of school (for example: Teays Valley High School).**

If the applicant does not meet the residency requirement, a waiver can be obtained from the GMoM Scholarship Committee upon request. The waiver will be reviewed and accepted at the discretion of the committee.

If the applicant does not meet the residency requirement, he/she must be a member or constituent of the GMoM. The applicant must attend Global Methodist on Main (formerly CPUMC) a majority of his/her high school years.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION:

In order to be eligible, applicants must have graduated from high school with at least a (B/3.0) average and pass the required proficiency testing for their complete high school experience. Applicants must be registering as a freshman at an accredited four-year college or an accredited two-year college with the intention of completing at least

four (4) years of college.

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS:

In order to qualify for a scholarship, the applicant must attend a college that is listed as accredited by one of the six regional accrediting associations and so listed in the Educational Directory, published by the U.S. Office of Education.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS:

Scholarships are awarded for educational purposes, not to afford a person an opportunity to develop his/her manual skills or to obtain proficiency in a trade or business.

PERIOD OF ELIGIBILITY:

An applicant otherwise eligible for scholarship benefits shall cease to be eligible one (1) year from the date of his/her graduation from high school. EXCEPTION: Military affiliation not to exceed four (4) years.

INITIAL APPLICATION:

To begin the application process, it is the applicant's responsibility to contact Teays Valley Guidance Advisor for a scholarship application.

ACADEMIC GRADE-POINT REQUIREMENTS:

Recipient eligibility requires maintaining a 2.0 (C) cumulative grade-point average during the academic year.

AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP:

One scholarship per year will be distributed. The scholarship amount of \$500 will be paid in installments commensurate with the college/university school year.

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

Scholarship monies are payable on a term-to-term basis consistent with the academic calendar (semesters/quarters) of the college attending. One-third of your grant will be distributed each quarter or one-half of

your grant will be distributed each semester. After receiving the first installment, future installments will be made once the church treasurer receives your grades.

REVISIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

This scholarship is subject to change at any time and to any extent, which the Scholarship Committee may consider necessary, in order to make best use of scholarship dollars. Further revisions will be publicized. Exceptions to any and all conditions governing the scholarship program can be made by the Scholarship Committee at any time it is deemed appropriate.

Scholarship recipients must recognize that Global Methodist on Main provides a fund for grants to students who have a genuine interest in education. Therefore, they are expected to conduct themselves in a manner in keeping with the high Christian ideals of the church. The Scholarship Committee may terminate any scholarship that it considers no longer advisable.

IMPORTANT

Every page MUST be completed in the timeframe given and returned, in its entirety, by 5:00pm on March 31, 2024.

The autobiographical letter is extremely important in the application process.

It is suggested you give your guidance counselor his/her section immediately and request your recommendation letter(s) from the appropriate people (non- relatives). The letter(s) is best given back to you to be returned with your application. Letters of recommendation may be emailed to the Scholarship Committee. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE SURE THE COMMITTEE HAS YOUR INFORMATION BY THE DEADLINE.

Each application will be reviewed for correct completion of each page and requirements. An application will be disqualified if the applicant fails to fill it out correctly and completely.
