

Jeff Sheets Leadership Award and Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize a graduating senior who has consistently displayed leadership qualities for TVHS and the surrounding community through his/her service, commitment and character. The recipient(s) of this scholarship will be considered based upon the similar qualities and demeanor in which Mr. Jeff Sheets demonstrated throughout his career as a student, athlete, educator and administrator for the Teays Valley Local Schools and Community. The committee will award one \$1,000 **or** two \$500 scholarships.

I. Applicant Criteria

- A. Must have been a TVHS student all four years of high school
- B. Must have participated in at least one school related activity
- C. Must have participated in at least one community service activity

II. Scholarship selection

The committee will be selected by the high school principal. It will consist of a minimum of two Teays Valley employees and one community member. An initial screening of applications may result in an interview.

III. Receipt of Payment of the Scholarship

Once the winner of the scholarship has been selected, the committee will make a recommendation on where to send the scholarship based upon future educational plans. It may be sent directly to an educational institution or sent directly to the family, depending upon the situation. The gift of the Jeff Sheets Leadership Award and Scholarship is provided in partnership with Kingston National Bank.

IV. Additional Recognition

A plaque honoring the annual recipient of this award will be displayed in the high school. This plaque is sponsored by the Teays Valley High School Student Council.
