

ASMC Buckeye Chapter High School Scholarship Program

<u>OBJECTIVE</u>: The objectives of the American Society of Military Comptrollers ASMC) Buckeye Chapter Scholarship Program are to recognize graduating high school seniors for academic achievement, to provide financial assistance to seniors in order that they may accomplish their future financial management baccalaureate educational goals, and to increase local chapter scholarship programs.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the final half of his/her school year, or a high school graduate within six months of the application deadline.
- Applicant must be entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management (such as business administration, economics, public administration, accounting, finance). Applications that do not fall within these fields will not be considered.
- Applicant must submit the current official ASMC Buckeye Chapter Scholarship Program Application Form.
- Applications must be typewritten and complete. Handwritten or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applicant must include the supporting documentation, as requested on the application, as part of their submission (e.g., Official transcript that includes GPA or other documentation as needed).
- Applicant must include, as part of their submission, a letter of recommendation from an academic official such as their high school principal, academic dean, guidance counselor, high school teacher, or volunteer organization point of contact.

<u>SELECTION PROCESS</u>: Applicant's scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, career/academic goals, and financial need will be considered and must be documented in the letter of recommendation and summarized on the form. A selection panel, chaired by a member of the ASMC Buckeye Chapter Scholarship Committee, will review all applications received and make final recommendations to the ASMC Buckeye Chapter Executive Committee, who will approve the final award winners. Students will be notified in April if their application has been selected as a winner. Checks are mailed directly to the school once a college acceptance letter has been received.

RECOGNITION: Notification/Proof of college enrollment will be required before disbursement of the scholarship check(s) to the winner(s) school bursar's office. The names of recipients may be publicized at local chapter meetings, newsletters, and at https://engage.asmconline.org/asmcbuckeyechapter/home. The ASMC Buckeye Chapter may submit scholarship winners to ASMC National for an opportunity to earn additional scholarships.

<u>**DEADLINE**</u>: Applications must be received by the ASMC Buckeye Chapter no later than **February 29, 2024** to be considered by the selection panel. No exceptions to this deadline will be allowed. Any applications received incomplete or after this date will not be considered for selection.
