Scholarship Deadlines

The Ashville Area Heritage Society is offering a \$1,000 scholarship that will be established to honor the memories of a person in whose name the Ashville Area Heritage Society Endowment was created. This Endowment was formed not only to help preserve and display local history, but also to promote educational and creative opportunities for youth in the Teays Valley School District. This is a one-year award only.

Applications must be submitted to the guidance office no later than May 8, 2023.

Scholarships must be claimed within one year of the award.

Selection Criteria

Recipients will be chosen on the basis of the following criteria with following weighting:

Scholarship Requirements

Candidate must be graduating senior of Teays Valley High School

Candidate must plan to pursue post-secondary education at an accredited college or university

Candidate may pursue any field of study, but preferences will be given to applicants planning on majoring in either the arts or higher learning

- Applicants may be asked to be interviewed
- Scholarship checks will be made payable to the institution of higher learning

Selection Committee

The Teays Valley Education Foundation Scholarship Committee shall present the top candidates, based on the afore mentioned eligibility criteria, to the Ashville Area Heritage Society Board of Trustees-who shall suggest the selection of the recipient. The Teays Valley Education Foundation shall have the final say, based on other scholarship selections.
