Scholarship Guidelines

This scholarship began in 2017 to honor the memory of Ashville Police Chief Douglas E Clark. For the 2023 year this will be \$1000.00 award to one person from a Pickaway County High School that meets the requirements. Chief Clark served as a 1st Responder in Pickaway County as a Firefighter/EMS and a Police Office since his graduation from Logan Elm High School beginning his senior year with the Pickaway Township Fire Department as a voluntary firefighter throughout his career, he was part of the Harrison Township Fire Department a Pickaway County Deputy and finished his career as the Village of Ashville Police Chief. Chief Clark passed away in November of 2017 after a battle with cancer. This scholarship is to help others who would like to pursue a career as a First Responder.

Scholarship Deadlines

Applications must be submitted to the Guidance Office of your High School by April 21, 2023. Scholarship must be claimed within one year of award and person must show proof of a First Responder class they are enrolled in to receive scholarship money.

Scholarship Requirements

- Candidate must be a 2023 graduating senior of a Pickaway County High School.
- Candidate must be pursuing a career as a First Responder in Law Enforcement, Fire or EMS.
- Candidate can be taking class at a College, University, Career and Technical School.
